<p><u>WP2</u> See corresponding presentation.</p> <p><u>Task 1:</u> Laura Petersen left IDEAAL project, as she found a permanent position.</p> <p>It will be up to the scientific partner of GANIL to have the same person in all committees or to nominate different persons.</p> <p>Nationality will not be a selection criterium for the PhD program co-financed by GANIL.</p> <p>As Intellectual property does not belong to GANIL and cannot be part of partnership agreement, so the Intellectual property has to be negotiated separately with CEA and CNRS.</p> <p><u>Task 2:</u> Interviews with involved persons accomplished recently. Workshop to be organized at GANIL with Philanthropia company.</p> <p><u>Task 3:</u> Feedback from IKBEST5 workshop held in Helsinki on April 9th-10th. Navin participated in this workshop. He approved the cost book creation.</p> <p>DESIR is not in costbook 1.0 according to Navin's request.</p> <p>Question of tax difference between countries.</p> <p>Iteration of Cost Book during the GANIL colloquium in September 2019?</p> <p>Doodle for the in-kind meeting at GANIL will be launched.</p> <p><u>Task 4:</u> Next deliverable for M30 (June 2019).</p> <p>The number of registered GANIL users did not seem to change since several months. <p><u>Task 1:</u> Cécile Merlin will leave IDEAAL project as she found a permanent position.</p> <p>Is the code of conduct addressed to all users (experimentalists + others)? Definition of users: persons registered on GANIL database.</p> <p>The real customers (industrials paying for the beam) are not included in the “customer” request procedure. Industrial users are not part of the GUEC, for the moment.</p> <p>The code of conduct and the request procedure (questionnaire to users after experiments at GANIL) will be submitted to the GUEC for further discussion before validation. GUEC is also preparing questionnaire for users. Maybe the request procedure may be used as common tool.</p> <p>Definition of collaboration in this context: a team proposing an experiment.</p> <p>This task, especially the update of access policy, needs to find human resources to finalize it.</p> <p><u>Task 2:</u> Valentin Rocton left the IDEAAL project as he found a permanent position. The calculation of the cost of the beam for SPIRAL2 was used for the ERINS proposal. Use for industrials: see WP4 presentation.</p> <p><u>Task 3:</u> Benjamin Fusberti left the IDEAAL project as he found a permanent position. Question of the transfer of data from one media to another in the storage process.</p> <p>The DMP describes among others what should be attached to the data (e.g. metadata).</p> <p><u>Task 4:</u> The GANIL reorganization caused modification of the deliverable for this task.</p> <p><u>Task 5:</u> Mobility agreement should be applicable to all staff members from partner institutions. We used mobility agreements from CEA and CNRS to write the GANIL mobility agreement. The mobility agreement was first thought for new partners. <p><u>WP4</u> See corresponding presentation.</p> <p><u>Task 1</u></p> <p>Radec company: tests of components to identify ions in space Seibersdorf company: test of electronics components for space</p> <p>In case of a second call, the internal selection criteria will be lightened in order to attract more companies, as usual companies have to propose new systems to develop.</p> <p>The beam cost was evaluated from the cost usually proposed to industrials. It is a marginal cost: electricity, fluids and operator costs. Investment costs are not included.</p> <p>Valentin’s tool to calculate beam costs will be used for the business plan on membranes.</p>	M.H. Moscatello & N. Renard

<p><u>Task 2</u> The mapping of exiting potential at GANIL presents the attractivity to industries vs the expertise domains of GANIL (see graph in the presentation).</p> <p>The MoU with ARRONAX presents 3 R&D topics on 211At production.</p> <p>ORANO Med focuses on 212Pb production.</p> <p>It seems that there is a competition between different production schemes for 212Pb.</p> <p>With SPIRAL2, GANIL can participate in R&D on both subjects (211At and 212Pb).</p> <p><u>Task 3</u> The person hired on this task will work at Saclay, with frequent visits at GANIL.</p> <p>In the aim of the deliverables at the end of the project, WP4 team produced intermediate reports to be used to write the final reports.</p>	
<p><u>WP5</u> See corresponding presentation.</p> <p>IPAC20: we have to see how to introduce this conference as an argument for extension of IDEAAL project.</p> <p>New user web site of GANIL: in the English version, the menu and the contents should be fully in English (to be modified)</p> <p>In “participating in an experiment”, the login should be the same as for user’s Web pag. (to be checked).</p> <p>Adam asks to create a folder dedicated and managed by GUEC with an access directly from the home page.</p>	<p>K. Turzó M. Depincé</p>
<p><u>Time extension of project</u></p> <p>See corresponding presentation.</p> <p>Is it necessary to extend the deadline of some deliverables?</p> <p>As long as SPIRAL2 is on the ESFRI list, GANIL is eligible for IDEAAL-type EU projects.</p> <p><u>Good reasons for an extension:</u></p> <p>WP2: T1: Finalisation of the student programme details. Signing the MoU with Poland and other scientific partners T2: Illustrate/validate the patronage/sponsorship offer with a specific partner T3: Launch of IKRB and CBWG in the beginning of 2020. Test the cost book (a good test case to find: S3? DESIR?). T4: Organisation of events to promote GANIL in enlarged community. Preparing the GANIL 2021 experimental campaign</p> <p>WP3: Due to reorganization, more time is needed for access policy implementation. We need also more time for the implementation of the DMP. 6 additional months will help to test the mobility agreement.</p>	<p>All</p>

<p>WP4: The temporary person working on the business plan can produce it in 8 months. With more time, it will be more detailed. On the other deliverables, more work can be done if more time is allowed. With the project extension, another call for industrial experiments can be organised. SPIRAL2 beams: possible if one-year extension.</p> <p>WP5: IPAC2020: important event to make GANIL known to accelerator engineers from all continents. GANIL Community meeting: possible if one-year extension.</p> <p>A discussion with the IDEAL project officer, Emiliano Carozza will be organized, in order to understand what would be good arguments from his point of view.</p> <p>Marek proposes to prepare the amendment request for June.</p> <p>IDEAL will propose to EC an extension of the project for 9 months (up to end of September 2020). The final report would then be prepared in October-November 2020.</p> <p>Action: each WP leader has to write down the arguments for extension for his/her own work package and send to coordinator - dead-line May 15, 2019.</p>
