*Today the launch of the Phase 2 of SPIRAL2 is not granted. It will happen most probably by the opening of GANIL (legal structure) to other countries*

Evaluation of the SPIRAL2 by ESFRI in 2017

*“An EU project IDEAAL will be active from 2017 to 2019 and its main goal is to set up the framework for for making GANIL/SPIRAL2 an international facility.”*

Next evaluation after the end of the IDEAAL project

Internationalisation of the GANIL-SPIRAL2 facility would allow to keep the status of SPIRAL 2 as a landmark facility
